On behalf of Prof. (Dr.) Sakshi Sharma, Secretary, Department of Health Research (DHR) and Director-General, Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) applications are invited from interested **MBBS/BDS students (1st year to 4th year (before appearing in 4th year final exams)) to participate in the Short Term Studentship-2022 (STS-2022).**

The ICMR embarked the STS Program in 1975 in order to promote interest and attitude for research among medical undergraduates. The main objective of the program is to provide an opportunity to undergraduate medical students to familiarize themselves with research methodology and techniques by being associated for a short duration with their seniors on an ongoing research program or by undertaking independent projects. It was expected that this may serve as an incentive for them to take up research as a career in the future.

During the last 37 years, medical/dental undergraduate students of various MCI/DCI recognized medical/dental colleges in the country have shown keen interest in ICMR-STS Program. The ICMR has decided to continue this program by awarding limited number of studentship to deserving MBBS/BDS students for the year 2022.

Approximately 1500 students (1200 seats- MBBS and 300 seats- BDS) will be awarded STS after the report submission and review for the year 2022.

Online registration starts from 21st January, 2022 (9:00am) only until 11th February, 2022 (by 5:00pm) and online application submission starting from 21st January, 2022 (9:00am) till 21st February, 2022 (by 5:00pm), which will be then evaluated by the DHR. The results will be announced by end of April or first week of May, 2022 and (a) of selected students to undertake STS research work will be displayed on the STS website. The selected students are expected to complete the project in any two given months between May, 2022 and September, 2022 and submit the report before the last date of submission i.e. 31st October, 2022 (Monday) by 5:00pm. The student will be awarded stipend and certificate only if his/her STS report is approved by ICMR. The institution must provide the student with all facilities for carrying out research and should bear the entire cost of the STS research work done by the student. The stipend issued to the selected students is his/her own studentship amount.

The value of the studentship from 2022 onwards has been increased to Rs. 25,000/- per month for two months duration (Total Rs. 50,000/- only) and it needs to be a stipend for the student only after final selection of his/her STS report.

## Oral changes associated with tobacco chewing according to frequency and duration of the habit: an observational study.

### Introduction:

Oral health contributes to overall general well-being of an individual. Oral diseases bother humans of all ages and pragmatically no individual in the course of their life time escapes from dental or oral diseases.<sup>1</sup> Oral mucosal lesions can arise as a result of infections, local trauma or irritation, systemic diseases and excessive consumption of tobacco, betel quid and alcohol<sup>2</sup>

Smokeless tobacco or tobacco chewing is one of the most frequent reasons of oral mucosal lesions which may include or transform into precancerous lesions and conditions. India is world's third largest tobacco growing country and second largest consumer of tobacco products in the world.<sup>3</sup> Tobacco smoking is widespread practice among young adults as cigarettes and bidis while smokeless tobacco includes pan masala (a mixture of dry tobacco, areca nut, betel leaf with lime, clove cardamom, mint, tobacco essence in the form of sweet granules), gutka (crushed betel nut, tobacco and sweet or savory flavourings) and mawa (thin shavings of areca nut with tobacco and slaked lime wrapped in a cellophane paper). Nicotine an alkaloid present in tobacco, is mainly accountable for addiction, which along with tobacco-specific nitrosamines, polycyclic aromatic hydrocarbons and many others act as potent carcinogens.<sup>4</sup> Chewing tobacco has been positively associated with oral lesions such as leukoplakia, oral submucous fibrosis and oral lichen planus, which further have the potential for malignant transformation. The type and location of the lesion varies with type of tobacco used and the direction of its use.<sup>5</sup>

### Objectives:

This study aims at variations of oral mucosa associated with tobacco chewing. The stage wise clinical changes of oral mucosa induced due to frequency and duration of the habit among each of the individuals, also the correlation between the frequency and duration of tobacco chewing habit and its effect on the oral mucosa.

### Methodology:

The study will be conducted particularly on the people i.e. tobacco chewers of marathwada region. Convenience sampling method will be employed for sample collection.

**Study design/ type of study:** A cross sectional study along with observational data will be done.

**Study methodology:** The patients will be informed and consent will be obtained prior to the intra oral examination in which regular dental instruments will be used. A detailed case history will be recorded for ruling out any systemic considerations. According to frequency and duration of habit of tobacco chewing the sample will further be divided into various groups and effect of the same on their oral mucosa will be compared.

**Sample size:** A sample size of approximately 100 tobacco chewers will be clinically assessed.

### Implications:

The present study will provide variations of oral mucosal changes according to the frequency and duration of the habit of tobacco chewing. Observations of all tobacco chewing patients and associated variations or no effect will be evaluated. The study will further help in convincing the user i.e. the patient to quit the habit by anticipating their further vulnerability to undergo such changes which will not only make it unpleasant in appearance but also will increase their risk towards the potentially malignant lesions and conditions that will affect their general health as a result.
